

Health and environmental risks


Covid, minefields, wild animals, heatwaves or extremely cold weather, poor infrastructure, provide us your route and we will highlight any health or environmental risks you may face.

Crime mapping








There is a lot more information out there than one can imagine. Social media, and the internet as a whole, remains one of the biggest sources of information security consultants use for the job.

Have a business overseas? Keep yourself updated on local laws and changes so as to not interrupt your business activity there.














Besides deliverables, we will work alongside you to develop long-term risk and security management strategies which can include:
